Ontario Mare Purchase Program for foals of 2018

Funding provided by: CTHS (Ontario Division) Enhanced HIP & Thoroughbred Improvement Program

- Purchasers of an in foal broodmare at the following 2017-2018 recognized public auctions Fasig-Tipton November Breeding Stock Sale, Sale, Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, Keeneland January Horses of All Ages Sale, OBS Winter Mixed Sale, Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Winter Mixed Sale and Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale are eligible to participate in said Mare Purchase Program (MPP). Eligible applicants will receive 50% of the purchase price up to a maximum of \$15,000 CDN per Mare purchased. There is also a maximum distribution of \$50,000 CDN for any one individual or partnership. Note: in order to be eligible there is a minimum purchase price of \$15,000 USD on any in foal mare.
- For the purposes of this program, Canadian and US dollars are considered at par.
- To be eligible to receive funds through this program the individual or partnership must be a resident(s) of Ontario. Proof of Residency will be required. In the event that a partnership includes a non-Ontario resident, proof of the percentage ownership of the Ontario resident will be required to establish the amount of incentive eligibility.
- Only in foal mares that are 12 years of age or younger (at the time of purchase) are eligible to the program.
- Incentive Program funds will be payable upon receipt of a letter of commitment made by the purchaser to the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society (Ontario Division) and payment will be issued when his/her application has bee approved. This application declares to the Program Administrator that said purchaser is committed to the following:
 - 1) the Mare will foal in Ontario in 2018 and be bred back to a Registered Ontario Sire, and
 - 2) the resulting 2018 and 2019 foals must either be sold in a sale conducted by the CTHS (Ontario Division) as a weanling or yearling or must make 2 starts in the Province of Ontario to qualify for the mare program. If said horse does not run 2 times prior to his/her 4 year-old-year he/she can apply to the integrity committee for an exemption, and
 - 3) said Mare must deliver her resulting 2019 Ontario Sired offspring in the province of Ontario, and
 - 4) the Registration Papers of the mare must be submitted with the program application and will be returned once the conditions/commitments made by the applicant are fulfilled.
- If a mare aborts or otherwise loses her 2018 foal, the applicant will still qualify provided the remaining program criteria be fulfilled.
- If the mare did not conceive when bred back to a Registered Ontario Sire during the 2018 breeding season, said mare must be bred back in 2019 to a Registered Ontario Sire (at least 2 estrus cycles) to complete the applicant's commitment. A Veterinary Certificate of said breeding must be supplied to the Program Administrator
- If the mare was unable to be bred during the 2018 breeding season, said mare must be bred back in 2019 to a Registered Ontario Sire (at least 2 estrus cycles) to complete the applicant's commitment and a Veterinary Certificate of said breeding must be supplied to the Program Administrator
- Ownership of the purchased mare cannot be transferred until the conditions/commitments made by the applicant are fulfillment.
- The Program Administrator, at its sole discretion, may make changes to the Mare Purchase Program criteria of any nature and kind whatsoever, including terms, conditions and distribution amounts. Program participants agree to be bound by such changes.
- Failure to provide the necessary supporting documentation as requested by the Program Administrator and/or non-fulfillment of the contract will result in ineligibility to the program and the legal requirement to reimburse the administrator for any program funds received plus a 20% penalty.
- The Program Administrator shall have the right to take any means necessary to facilitate the return of the funds including but not limited to a lien against any Breeders Awards earned up to the amount due.
- The Program Administrator may, at any time, verify the information provided on the application such information includes, but not limited to, purchase price, ownership, etc. If this verification provides details that are not in keeping with the criteria of the program applicants will be required to return any amounts issued to them by the program.
- The total funds for this program are \$500,000. Once all required documentation is received to complete the application ³/₄ of the eligible incentive payment will be distributed and if oversubscribed the distribution of the remaining incentive payments will be prorated based on applications received
- The Program Administrator will conduct random checks and if deemed appropriate reserves the right to review any purchase to ensure that all purchases are bona fide transactions. Any illicit conduct with regards to the purchase of mares that are entered into the program will be dealt with by the appropriate legal action.
- Any dispute shall be resolved by an arbitration panel selected by the Program Administrator. All decisions of the arbitration panel will be deemed final and binding.
